





TRINITY PREPARATION AND EXAM

We want to ensure the student's take home more than just an amazing experience so every student will be prepared for and take a Trinity Examination at the end of the course.

Trinity Examinations are regulated in the UK by Ofqual and are trusted by many universities, educational organisations and commercial organisations around the world as robust evidence of English Language Proficiency

Students will take the Trinity GESE in which speaking and listening is assessed in dynamic, unscripted one-to-one conversation. GESE exams are suitable for all students, whatever their level, from absolute beginner to advanced.
